

t. **Puerto Rico Counterdrug Service Ribbon (PRCSR)**



(1) The Puerto Rico National Guard Counterdrug Service Ribbon is presented at the discretion of the Adjutant General or Chief of Staff to a member of the Puerto Rico Army or Air National Guard. The member must have performed Federal Active Duty in support of the Puerto Rico Counterdrug Support Task Force for a minimum period of one year. Counterdrug operations include supply reduction, demand reduction and substance abuse prevention missions.

(2) Subsequent Awards: A Bronze Service Star for each additional award and a Silver Service Star in lieu of five Bronze Service Stars.

(3) Method of Submission: Counterdrug Coordinator will make recommendations for this award to the Counterdrug Personnel Office. Counterdrug Coordinator will certify by memo to the Military Personnel Section that individuals have met the proposed criteria.

(4) Description: The proposed ribbon will be of standard size. The colors and sizing will be as follows: From left to right: 5/16" light orange, 1/16" white, 3/16" Army green, 1/16" white, 1/8" light orange, 1/16" white, 3/16" Air Force blue, 1/16" white, and 5/16" light orange.

(5) Color Significance: Light orange represents joint operations of the Counterdrug Task Force. Green represents the activities of the Army National Guard. Blue represents the activities of the Air National Guard and White represents purity and honors as the Counterdrug Task Force strives to make Puerto Rico a drug-free territory.

(6) Order of Precedence: Order of precedence for this ribbon is immediately after the PRNG Law Enforcement Ribbon and before the PRNG Active Duty for Training Ribbon.
